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The seventh season of **DragonflyTV**, an Emmy-award winning show on PBS that highlights ordinary kids doing inquiry-based science investigations, explores nanoscale science and technology. Penn State MRSEC research on using nano-iron for groundwater remediation, as well as a museum activity at the Franklin Institute developed as part of the *Small Wonders* museum show, are featured in an episode on nanotechnology and society. With widespread distribution on PBS stations as well as online streaming, **DragonflyTV Nano** reaches a nationwide audience of kids and inspires them to think about nanoscale science and its real-life applications. This season's episodes began airing in November 2008.



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
